Capital Christian Middle School is a college preparatory school offering a variety of core courses and electives across the curriculum. CCMS combines strong academics with a dedication to providing a Christ-centered environment, permeating everything from the classroom to the athletic field and stage. CCMS enjoys the full use of a 63-acre campus and athletic facility which includes 14 classrooms, 2 science labs, 4 technology labs, a robotics room, a full-service cafeteria, a performing arts center, 4 athletic fields, a football/soccer stadium, and a full-size gymnasium.

COMMUNITY PROFILE

Capital Christian Middle School is a commuter campus that serves students from 15 different communities in the greater Sacramento area. CCMS is proud to host an academically diverse student body and appropriately addresses all learning styles. CCMS offers courses for students who have learning differences, including support through NILD (National Institute for Learning Development). The school's campus is located in Sacramento off of Highway 50 and Bradshaw Avenue, and represents an ethnically diverse student body. Over 120 churches are represented by our student body and approximately 25% of students receive financial assistance.

ACCREDITATION

Capital Christian Middle School maintains dual accreditation with the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). The current term of WASC accreditation is six years, through 2020.
